Whether in-person or remote, please upload a PDF of your poster and a video recording (maximum length will be announced by **Wed, June 1**). In-person poster presenters may opt for an audio recording. This will allow remote attendees to access all posters.

In-person posters details

Posters should be set up in the designated reception room (TBC) at Bolger Center, 9600 Newbridge Dr, Potomac, MD, on the morning of Tues, June 14 between 9 am and 12 pm EDT.

The poster session will occur later that day between 5 pm and 6 pm EDT.

Your poster must fit on the provided poster board: 36" x 48"

- Your poster video is a pre-recorded video of you presenting a poster or short slide deck and the length and other logistics will be announced by Wed, June 1.
- Your video should be succinct, streamlined and focused on your "take home" message.
