How to Participate

- Indicate your interest in presenting a poster when completing the [registration form](#). If you haven't registered yet, please do!
 - **Submit your abstract** via the [Abstract Submission Form](#) by **Friday, May 16**. (See details below)
 - All accepted presenters will be required to:
 - Upload a **PDF version of their poster** for remote access. Note, you may opt out of this if your poster includes sensitive/unpublished data.
 - Upload **your photo** for the attendee materials.
 - Upload a **PowerPoint slide of their Lightning Talk** (optional)
 - Bring a **printed copy** of their poster for display.
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Important Dates

- **Friday, May 16:** Abstract submission deadline
 - **Wednesday, May 22:** Notification of acceptance
 - **Friday, May 30:** Deadline to upload poster PDF, photo (and PowerPoint slide, optional)
 - **Tuesday, June 3, 3:20 PM PDT:** Poster session at the FaceBase 2025 Annual Meeting
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Poster Session Format

- Posters will be displayed in a designated area, with materials provided for hanging.
 - A high-resolution **PDF of each poster** will be made available for remote attendees (you may opt out of this if there is sensitive data).
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Abstract Submission Guidelines

- **Format:** Word document (.DOCX or .DOC)
 - **Length:** 250 words maximum (excluding title and author list)
 - **Title:** Limited to 10 words
 - **Template:** Download the abstract template [here](#)
 - **Submission:** Upload via the [Abstract Submission Form](#) by **May 16**.
 - **Confirmation:** You will receive an email confirming your submission.
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Poster Preparation & Submission

- **Size:** Recommended **36" x 48" (landscape orientation)**
 - **Printing:** Presenters are responsible for printing their own posters.
 - **Setup:** Posters should be hung in the designated room (11th floor - *Room TBA*) between **3:10 PM - 3:30 PM PDT**.
 - **Digital Upload:** A **PDF of your poster** must be uploaded via the [Poster Upload Form](#) by **Friday, May 30**.
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Lightning Talk Preparation & Submission

- **Standard Formats:** Use a common aspect ratio like 16:9 or 4:3 to ensure your slide displays correctly on different screens without distortion.
 - **Guidelines:**
 - **Keep It Simple:** Use minimal text—a single, concise title and 3–4 key bullet points or visuals. The idea is to provide a snapshot of your research.
 - **Visual Impact:** Include a clear and striking image, graph, or schematic that represents your work. Visuals can convey complex ideas quickly.
 - **Readable Design:** Ensure text is large and high contrast so that it can be seen easily from a distance. Avoid overcrowding the slide.
 - **Digital Upload:** A **PowerPoint slide of your lightning talk** must be uploaded via the [Poster Upload Form](#) by **Friday, May 30**.
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Suggested Poster Topics

We encourage submissions related to:

- **Basic, translational, and clinical research** advancing FaceBase aims
- **Machine learning (ML) and AI applications** in craniofacial research
- **Data reuse:** Demonstrations of how FaceBase data contributes to new scientific insights.

- Data should be hosted by FaceBase or will be submitted to FaceBase in the near future.
